FGSZ along with MEKH, the Hungarian national regulatory authority, and Transgaz along with ANRE, the Romanian national regulatory authority, kindly invite you to their joint network user information days as follows.

Background

In July 2012 SNTGN TRANSGAZ S.A. and FGSZ Ltd. signed a Memorandum of Understanding on further improving the cooperation of the two TSOs. In compliance with the Memorandum of Understanding the two TSOs launched a pilot project, supported by both ANRE and MEKH, for the early implementation of Commission Regulation (EU) No 984/2013 (CAM NC). Within the framework of the pilot, the TSOs will allocate firm monthly capacities of the Hungarian exit and the Romanian entry point as well as firm monthly capacities of the Hungarian entry and the Romanian exit point at the interconnection point of Csanádpalota as bundled capacity products. The standard capacity products and allocation mechanisms applied during the capacity allocation are in compliance with the stipulations of the CAM NC, using the Regional Booking Platform (RBP), an online capacity booking platform developed by FGSZ.
